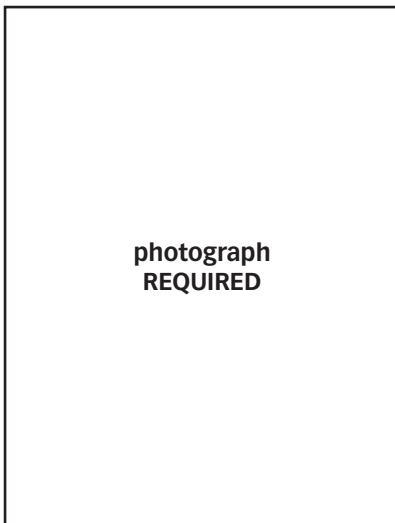




THE AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP

NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

Any Team Manager or Head Coach of an American Legion (Post – affiliated) team may nominate one player for consideration of his award. The scholarship application, letters of recommendation and certification form must be completed, postmarked and mailed to the Department (state) Headquarters no later than **July 15, 2006**. Three letters of testimony must be attached to the nomination form.

Attach a one - page letter of recommendation from your:

- (1) Legion Coach or Team Manager,
- (2) American Legion Post Commander or Adjutant
- (3) Community Leader, (i.e. teacher, minister, Scout leader, Church Leader, Principal)

Letters of recommendation are an important part of this application and will be carefully reviewed by the selection committee.

Each Department (state) Baseball Committee will select an American Legion Player who best meets the qualifications as the 2006 AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP WINNER.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Fifty-one (51) players (one per Department) will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship as The American Legion – Scholarship winner.

Scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive their scholarships immediately upon graduation from an accredited high school. Scholarship winners must utilize the total award within eight (8) years of their graduation date, excluding active military duty.

The scholarship may be used to attend a school selected by the student providing it is state accredited and above the high school level.

The National Treasurer of The American Legion will make disbursement from the scholarship fund jointly to the student and the school at the beginning of each semester.

THE PLAYER MUST:

- Attached a copy of your official high school transcript.
- Have graduated from high school.
- Be on 2006 roster - (American Legion National Baseball Registration Form #1) that has been filed with National Headquarters
- Be part of a team affiliated with an American Legion Post.
- Have three letters of testimony attached to application.

(Do not send application directly to National Headquarters!)

Applicant should type or print all information

Application and testimonial letters must be postmarked to the Department (State) Headquarters no later than July 15, 2006.
